Arca Continental recognized for its sustainability leadership with seventh inclusion in Dow Jones Best-In-Class

Monterrey, Mexico, May 1, 2026 – Arca Continental, S.A.B. de C.V. (BMV: AC*) (“Arca Continental” or “AC”), one of the largest Coca-Cola bottlers in the world, has been included in the prestigious Dow Jones Best-In-Class MILA Pacific Alliance for the seventh consecutive year, reinforcing its sustainability leadership.

The Dow Jones Best-In-Class MILA Pacific Alliance evaluates leading companies by sector that are part of the S&P MILA Pacific Alliance Composite and recognizes only those that outperform their peers in environmental, social, and governance criteria, and that integrate sustainability as a core element of their business strategy.

Arca Continental’s continued presence in this index for seven consecutive years reflects the strength of its sustainable business model, as well as its long-term commitment to decarbonizing its operations, efficient water management, advancing the circular economy initiatives through packaging recycling, developing its value chain, and generating shared value in the communities where it operates.

As part of its integrated sustainability approach, Arca Continental reported significant progress in its [Integrated Annual Report](#), including an average use of 36.6% recycled resin in its packaging, 39% renewable energy in its production facilities, and nearly 600,000 people benefiting from water access programs.

This performance adds to the company’s recent inclusion, for the fourth consecutive year, in the S&P Global Sustainability Yearbook within the Beverages industry, one of the most recognized international publications in the field.

These recognitions reaffirm Arca Continental’s vision of generating sustainable value beyond its operations, strengthening its positive impact on communities, customers, and strategic partners across the five countries where it operates.
